The Fort Calhoun Rescue Squad has the distinction of having the most volunteer paramedics per capita than any other rescue team in the State of Nebraska. Fort Calhoun Fire/Rescue and the fire hall is located at 600 N. 14th Street proudly protects 5000 people living in an area of 68 square miles. We operate out of one station that protects a suburban/rural area. Our department is a public department whose members are all volunteers. Fort Calhoun Fire/Rescue was established in 1913 and the District was formed in 1956. Presently there are 28 members that handle both fire and rescue calls serving at the EMT-BASIC, EMT-I, and Paramedic levels. The City of Fort Calhoun has a population of 856.
